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## Facts and Figures



Since the end of 2019, renowned experts have been treating around 24,000 people who come to the University Hospital of Cologne each year for outpatient treatment with cancer in an area of almost 14,000 square meters spread over seven floors.

The architecture of the new therapy building, designed by a subsidiary of the Uniklinik Köln, is also intended to ensure that the often traumatized cancer patients feel as comfortable as possible. In addition to the building's appealing SUMMER exterior facade, which is designed to blend in with its surroundings in terms of color, the new CIO has two light-filled inner courtyards, one of which has a three-story roof as an entrance atrium.
