## Facts and Figures



The attractive new building with a partially natural stone facade blends seamlessly into the Nuremberg cityscape. The ensemble consists of two towers with 10 and 15 above-ground floors respectively, which form the gateway to the adjacent old town, and two building blocks with seven and eight upper floors. Adjacent is the historic round building along Allersberger Strasse, whose facade design has been preserved. After twenty years of vacancy, this is now coming back to life and, together with the new building, is creating space for more than 800 hotel rooms, 12,000 m<sup>2</sup> of office space, a 1,500 m<sup>2</sup> city market and 2,500 m<sup>2</sup> of service space for selected service providers such as Deutsche Post and Postbank.
